### What do I do?

Write creatively by discussing a given topic

## **Top Tips!**

- Plan your work carefully
- Write a clear introduction, paragraph your work carefully, presenting a range of ideas and write a convincing conclusion
- Reach a decision and summarise save your decision/opinion until the end.
- · Create facts and figures to support your point of view - yes, you can make these up!
- You could grab your reader's attention from the start, by using a rhetorical question

## What skills do Ineed to improve?



Doing lots of practice questions will help with becoming familiar with question types but what else can you do to improve in this area?

- Discussing a wide variety of topics with your friends and family will help you to understand different perspectives and opinions
- Topics could range from wearing uniform at school to discussions about the news
- You need to consider all points of view in your writing until you reveal your own personal opinion in your conclusion
- Use a wide variety of vocabulary and try to use the third person (in the main!) and a passive voice

#### <u>Introduction</u>

#### You could use a statement

Emphasise your points made Arrive at a conclusion and YOUR opinion
