What do I do?

Find the net that belongs to the cube on the left.




- The trick is to try to visualise the net folded into a cube.
- Be careful the images in the net may need to be rotated to look like the cube on the left.
- There are a range of physical resources that you can buy to help with revision. A magnetic cube whiteboard is the best for these types of questions <u>https://amzn.to/46vaTQ5</u>
- There are 11 possible nets of a cube can you draw them all?

What skills do I need to improve?


