Rhyming Synonyms

What do I do?

Find a word that rhymes with the word in CAPITAL **LETTERS** <u>and</u> is a synonym of the missing word in the sentence. The **synonym of the missing word** will be your answer and not the missing word in the sentence.

Top Tips!



- Be careful of sneaky traps that are there to catch
- The missing word could be listed don't be fooled - it's the synonym you're after NOT the one that rhymes with the clue word.
- Another word could be listed that is a synonym of the rhyming word but doesn't make sense in the sentence - it's not that one either!

Example



Clue word - this rhymes with the missing word in the sentence...

Although he wasn't a keen gardener, Alex decided to TRIM his rose bush.



- a) prune
- b) water
- c) feed
- d) weed

word TRIM - this is your answer.

Step 2: PRUNE is a synonym of the

BUT WAIT... that's not your answer!

WATCH OUT! Water, feed and weed all make sense in the sentence - but they're



The missing word is TRIM, which rhymes with the clue word - SWIM and is a synonym of the word PRUNE. Therefore, the answer is **PRUNE**.

not a synonym of TRIM. The word TRIM is in there too - sneaky, sneaky!
