#### **Top Tips!**

- It is much easier to take one letter at a time and figure out the pattern that way. If you're tackling this type of question for the first time, highlight the first letter of each pair and use your alphabet to decide which direction and how many letters it's moving. (+3, -2 etc)
- Watch out for a mirror pattern! The 'mirror line' on the alphabet is between M and N.

### What skills do Ineed to improve?



Doing lots of practice questions will help with becoming familiar with question types but what else can you do to improve in this area?

- Any sequencing questions will help whether that's VR or maths.
- · When you're out and about or on long journeys, see if you can invent some alphabet-related games to improve your knowledge of the alphabet and where each letter is. 'Which letter comes before P?' etc.
- Any alphabet-related topics will help other question types involving alphabet positions or word order are also great revision tools.
