What do I do?

Top Tips!



- Try writing the numbers 1-8 across the two words
 separated by the brackets
- Figure out your letter options and if there's more than one letter the same, write both down to see if either make a word
- Revise tricky 3 letter words in order to recognise them, especially those starting with a vowel - ire, ilk, ore...
- See if you can create your own 'use a rule' problem to test your family and friends

What skills do I need to improve?



Doing lots of practice questions will help with becoming familiar with question types but what else can you do to improve in this area?

- Revise common letter strings and word families such as: 'ight', 'ough', 'our' and 'ear'. Create mind maps of each of them.
- Revise more anagram type questions along with question types that jumble up words in a sentence.
- Play games such as 'Boggle' to see how many words you can find from a set of letters in one minute.
